

**RESOLUTION NO. 1000-17**

**A RESOLUTION SETTING EMPLOYEES WAGES**

**WHEREAS**, the State of Colorado requires that each municipality owning and operating water or wastewater plants must have employees who are state certified in the areas of water, and wastewater; and

**WHEREAS**, Brent Bitter, public works employee, successfully passed the State of Colorado's Class "D" Wastewater certification on June 23, 2017; and

**WHEREAS**, Brent Bitter, public works employee, successfully passed the State of Colorado's Class "1" Distribution certification on June 23, 2017; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees desires to reward public works employees who successfully pass State of Colorado water and wastewater certification tests; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees desires to adjust the hourly wage of the Town Clerk to reduce the spread between the hourly wage of the town treasurer and the town clerk where both share many duties.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Town of Fowler's Board of Trustees as follows.

1. The hourly wage of Brent Bitter, public works employee, is increased from \$11.73 to \$12.73 effective upon the first day of the pay period that commenced June 18, 2017.
2. The hourly wage of Kelly Lotrich, town clerk is increased from \$14.74 to \$16.24 effective upon the first day of the pay period that commenced July 2, 2017.
3. This resolution is effective upon adoption.
