

**RESOLUTION NO. 1001-17**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EMPLOYEE TRAINING**

**WHEREAS**, the town of Fowler provides training for various positions throughout the town to improve employees' technical ability and for professional advancement; and

**WHEREAS**, the University of Colorado at Denver provides a Certified Public Managers' program designed to assist in the professional development of individuals working in federal, state or local government that desire to improve their government management skills; and

**WHEREAS**, the University of Colorado's program is affiliated with the National Certified Public Managers Consortium which sets and preserves national standards for the Certified Public Managers' designation; and

**WHEREAS**, the program requires classwork on a Friday and Saturday once every other month in Denver and additional on line work; and

**WHEREAS**, the program requires one year to complete all courses plus a capstone project at the end of the courses; and

**WHEREAS**, whereas the cost of each class is five-hundred dollars for a total program cost of \$3,300 including the cost of the capstone project of which the cost in 2017 for courses would be \$1,000.00; and

**WHEREAS**, Kelly Lotrich has expressed interest in attending the Certified Public Managers' program and has the requisite experience and educational background to enroll in the program.

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Fowler, Colorado as follows.

1. The administration is authorized to expend one-thousand dollars for Certified Public Manager tuition in 2017 and to reimburse Kelly Lotrich for travel expenses incurred to attend the classes.
2. The administration is instructed to include expenses for the Certified Public Manager classes and travel expenses in the 2018 budget.
