

RESOLUTION NO. 986-16

A RESOLUTION SETTING PUBLIC WORKS EMPLOYEE'S WAGES

WHEREAS, the State of Colorado requires that each municipality owning and operating water or wastewater plants must have employees who are state certified in the areas of water, and wastewater; and

WHEREAS, Richard Spaccamonti, public works director, successfully passed the State of Colorado's Class "3" Distribution certification test on November 4, 2016; and

WHEREAS, Richard Spaccamonti, public works director, successfully passed the State of Colorado's Class "2" Collection certification on November 4, 2016; and

WHEREAS, Brent Bitter, public works employee, successfully passed the State of Colorado's Class "1" Collection certification on November 4, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees desires to reward public works employees who successfully pass State of Colorado water and wastewater certification tests.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town of Fowler's Board of Trustees as follows.

1. The hourly wage of Richard Spaccamonti, public works director, is increased from \$19.81 to \$20.81 effective upon the first day of the current pay period.
2. The hourly wage of Brent Bitter, public works employee, is increased from \$11.00 to \$11.50 effective upon the first day of the current pay period.
3. This resolution is effective upon adoption.
