

RESOLUTION NO. 993-17

A RESOLUTION SETTING POLICE CHIEF WAGE

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees approved a wage increase for the police chief commencing on January 8, 2017; and

WHEREAS, Jacob Freidenberger will be employed by the Town of Fowler in the capacity of police chief on January 8, 2017; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to formally set a wage for Jacob Freidenberger.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Fowler as follows.

1. The salary for police chief Jacob Freidenberger is set at \$1,600.00 per two week pay period commencing January 8, 2017.
2. The salary for police chief Jacob Freidenberger is set at \$1,631.92 per two week pay period upon satisfactory completion of twelve (12) months employment commencing at the start of the pay period set forth in paragraph 1 above.
3. The salary for police chief Jacob Freidenberger is set at \$1,680.88 per two week pay period upon satisfactory completion of twenty-four (24) months employment commencing at the start of the pay period set forth in paragraph 1 above.
4. The salary for police chief Jacob Freidenberger is set at \$1,705.80 per two week pay period upon satisfactory completion of thirty-six (36) months employment commencing at the start of the pay period set forth in paragraph 1 above.
5. The salary for police chief Jacob Freidenberger is set at \$1,730.76 per two week pay period upon satisfactory completion of forty-eight (48) months employment commencing at the start of the pay period set forth in paragraph 1 above.
