

**RESOLUTION NO. 999-17**

**A RESOLUTION SETTING PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR'S WAGE**

**WHEREAS**, Daniel Sotomayor ("Sotomayor") has been hired as the Town of Fowler's Public Works Director; and

**WHEREAS**, Daniel Sotomayor ("Sotomayor"), has four-years' experience with public water and wastewater systems serving as the Public Works Director for Calhan, Public Works Director for Simila and as water and wastewater operator for the Meridan Service Metropolitan District (the prior public works director had four and a quarter years equivalent experience); and

**WHEREAS**, Sotomayor holds the equivalent of eight certifications for which the town grants pay increases one less than the prior public works director; and

**WHEREAS**, four of the eight certifications are required for the Town of Fowler's water and wastewater systems the same number held by the prior public works director.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Town of Fowler's Board of Trustees as follows.

1. The hourly wage of Daniel Sotomayor, public works director, is set at \$22.88 per hour effective upon the first day of hire.
2. This resolution is effective upon adoption.
