

RESOLUTION NO. 1143-23

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING PROCEDURES FOR THE 2024 MUNICIPAL ELECTION

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees is authorized by C.R.S. §1-7.5-104 to determine than a municipal election may be conducted by mail ballot; and

WHEREAS, three trustee positions must be filled in the 2024 election; and

WHEREAS, one mayor position must be filled in the 2024 election; and

WHEREAS, the town of Fowler is not divided into various wards; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to determine in advance how four-year terms and two- year terms shall be determined, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to authorize the town clerk to appoint election judges.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IS RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Fowler, Colorado as follows.

1. The 2024 municipal election shall be conducted by mail ballots.
2. After the ballots for election of trustees have been counted, the two candidates who obtain the greatest number of votes shall be deemed to have been elected to four year terms and the one candidate who receives the third greatest number of votes shall be deemed to have been elected to a two-year term.
3. In case of a tie, so that the distinction between four- year terms and two -year terms cannot be made, the tie shall be broken by lot in a manner mutually acceptable to the tied candidates and conducted by the town clerk.
4. Where no contest exists and the election is vacated pursuant to Colorado law, four -year terms and two- year terms shall be determined by lot in a manner mutually acceptable to all candidates and conducted by the town clerk.
5. The town clerk is authorized to appoint three (3) election judges for the municipal election.
